ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES



SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS



ORIGINAL WORK

The abstract must be an original work and must not have been published elsewhere.



MAXIMUM 300 WORDS

The abstract must be limited to a maximum of 300 words.



FONT

Use Times New Roman font for the entire abstract.



FONT SIZE

The font size must be 12 pt.



LINE SPACING

Use 1.5 line spacing throughout the document.



MARGINS

Maintain 1 inch margin on all sides of the page.



PEER REVIEW PROCESS

All abstracts will go through a peer review process.



REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT

Only registered delegates are eligible to submit an abstract.



ABSTRACT STRUCTURE

01



TITLE

Bold and concise. Avoid abbreviations.

02



AUTHORS

List all authors. Underline the presenting author. Use commas to separate names.

03



AFFILIATIONS

Provide full postal address of each affiliation as per superscript numbers.

04



EMAIL

Email ID of presented author.

05



BACKGROUND

Brief introduction, problem statement, rationale and significance.

06



OBJECTIVES

Clearly state the primary aim(s) and objectives of the study.

07



METHODOLOGY

Study design, setting, participants, data collection methods and analysis.

08



RESULTS

Key findings with relevant numerical data; concise and evidence-based.

09



CONCLUSION

Summarize major findings and their implications.

10



KEYWORDS

Provide 3-6 relevant keywords.



IMPORTANT



No references in the abstract.



No tables in the abstract.



No figures in the abstract.



Avoid abbreviations at first appearance in the text.



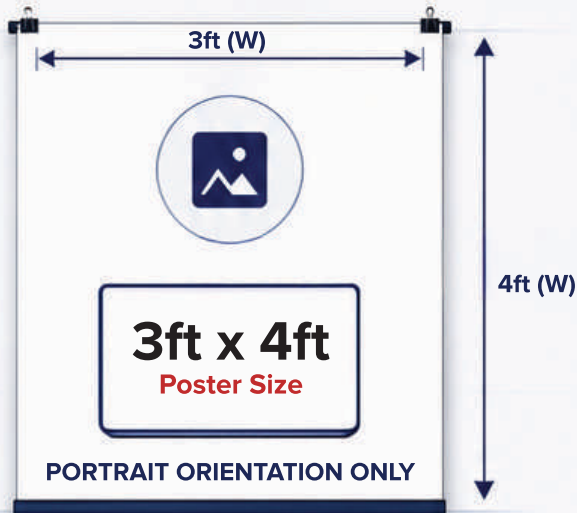

Title
Bold and clear. Avoid abbreviations.



Authors
Underline the presenting author.



Affiliation
Full postal address as per superscript numbers.



Keywords
3-6 relevant keywords.



Abstract
Maximum 300 words

POSTER PRESENTATION REQUIREMENTS



Display your poster at least 1 hour before the session begins.



Be present during the session to explain your work and respond to queries.



Posters will remain on display until 5:00 PM on the presentation day.



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ORAL PRESENTATION

PRESENTATION FORMAT



Software
Microsoft PowerPoint (.ppt/.pptx)



Slides
8-10 slides
(excluding title and acknowledgement/conclusion slides)



Orientation
Landscape format only

PRESENTATION REQUIREMENTS



Presentations should be concise and focused on key findings.



Use clear figures, tables and graphs where appropriate.



Avoid excessive text on slides.



Maintain consistency in font style and formatting.



Ensure all data presented are accurate and ethically reported.

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TITLE OF THE ABSTRACT

(Bold, Title Case, Maximum 25 Words)

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Abstract

Background

Provide a brief introduction to the study, including the problem statement, rationale, and significance of the research (50–100 words).

Objectives

Clearly state the primary aim(s) and objectives of the study (30–50 words).

Methodology

Describe the study design, setting, participants, interventions (if any), data collection methods, and statistical analysis used (75–150 words).

Results

Present the key findings with relevant numerical data wherever possible. Results should be concise and evidence-based (75–150 words).

Conclusion

Summarize the major findings and their implications for research, clinical practice, public health, or policy (50–100 words).

Keywords

3–5 keywords separated by commas.

IMPORTANT NOTES



REGISTERED DELEGATES ONLY

Only registered delegates are eligible to present.



CERTIFICATES

Certificates will be issued only to registered presenters.
